THE MODULE

ACCESS OPTIONS

MSc option

- On successful completion of a module, 20 M Level credits/10 ECTS will be awarded.
- Summative assessment is integrated throughout each module.

Continuing professional development option

- You will follow the same curriculum as with the MSc, but there is no assessment or accreditation linked to this option.
- On completion of the module, you will receive a certificate of attendance for your portfolio.
