We offer the opportunity to work in a transregional active perinatal centre level III with the most advanced treatment options in the interdisciplinary cooperation with the specialisation areas prenatal diagnostics & foetal therapy, paediatric surgery, paediatric cardiology and neuropediatric. Within the scope of our clinical and scientific specialisation area "Control of the non-invasive ventilation via monitoring of the CNS and the lung [Steuerung der nicht-invasiven Beatmung über Monitoring des ZNS und der Lunge]" in the case of premature babies and new-borns in cooperation with the University of Applied Sciences Mittelhessen (THM) under the umbrella of the German Center for Lung Research (DZL) you will have the opportunity to further your academic career, including habilitation.

The UKGM employs an operational health management for its employees and is certified as a family friendly employer. The clinical centre operates a day care centre.

Medical / scientific / dental employees working at the UKGM are employed as scientific employees by the Federal State and for this reason are eligible to receive the State ticket for the use of the local and regional public transport in Hesse. The ticket is, at first, valid until 31.12.2019. The remuneration is based on the Hesse bargaining agreement for physicians at the university hospitals. Severely disabled applicants of equal aptitude will be preferably hired within the scope of applicable regulations. To increase the number of women employed in scientific areas, we strongly encourage, in particular, qualified female scientists to apply. We want to expressly point out that sharing of full time positions is generally possible.
