ESPR Young Investigator START-UP GRANTS 2020

Amount: EUR 10,000 per grant. (The committee wishes to encourage in particular proposals from Eastern European countries.)

Purpose: To help young investigators establish, perform or complete a small basic or clinical research project in all fields related to Paediatrics.

Eligibility Requirements: At the time of submission, applicants should be:

- within 10 years of having received a degree in their undergraduate qualification in biomedical sciences/medicine/life sciences.
- ESPR members or intending to join the society, supported by their supervisors/hosts who are ESPR members.
- willing to present their research findings at an ESPR conference.

ESPR Nursing GRANTS 2020

Amount: EUR 5,000 per grant.

Purpose: To help young research nurses or allied health professional establish, perform or complete a small basic or clinical research project in all fields related to Paediatrics.

Eligibility Requirements: At the time of submission, applicants should be:

- ESPR members or intending to join the society, supported by their supervisors/hosts who are ESPR members.
- willing to present their research findings at an ESPR conference.

ESPR Post-Doc RESEARCH GRANTS 2020

Amount: EUR 25,000 per grant.

Purpose: To support a research project for established researchers in all fields related to Paediatrics.

Eligibility Requirements: At the time of submission, applicants should:

- be within 15 years of having received their undergraduate qualification in biomedical sciences/medicine/life sciences.
- have a proven track record in research.
- be ESPR members.
- be willing to present their research findings at an ESPR conference.
